

How to change your CruzID Blue Password

Use your web browser to go the CruzID Manager at cruzid.ucsc.edu.

CruzID Manager is a website where you can change and set password associated with your CruzID. More features will be available from CruzID manager in the future.

Sign in to CruzID Manager

- 1) Enter your CruzID, not your email address, just the unique part to the left of the @ sign.
- 2) Enter your familiar CruzID password. Because we have more than one password associated with your CruzID, it now has a name.
- 3) Click “Sign in”



Sign In to CruzID Manager

Welcome to the CruzID Manager. Please enter your CruzID and your **CruzID Blue** password to Sign In.

The CruzID Manager allows you to change your CruzID Blue and CruzID Gold passwords. Your CruzID Blue password is the same password you have used to access common campus applications including CruzMail, CruzNet, ResNet and Instructional Labs. The CruzID Gold password is a new campus password that over time will be used to access certain UC Santa Cruz applications. Change CruzID Password

To change your CruzID password - enter your existing password, your new password, confirm the new password, then click **Change Password**.
