Faculty Persistent URL update [A. Hesse]

Andrea gave a demo of how faculty can now manage their own personal site via people.ucsc.edu. It is an easy-to-use single publishable URL that can be used to link to each persona (faculty, researcher, etc.), authenticated by blue password. WordPress, the web publishing service tool, pilots in May and will be in production by fall quarter. Communication will go out to faculty at that time.

Andrea Hesse has been working with Lisa Bono on establishing a web presence featuring IT services that are particularly important to faculty. Service catalog is now live.

Wireless in Classrooms [M. Doyle]

Mary received a letter from the chair of CCT stating that UCSC should have wireless access in all larger than 75 seat classrooms, beginning implementation in Fall 2014. Mary has asked Jim and Doug what exists currently and what needs to be done to reach that goal. Mary will report back to CCT at their next meeting on Apr. 9.

UCPath update [M. Doyle]

UCSC will be the second implementation after UCOP goes live in Jan. 2015. Steering and Leadership committees are working on who is most ready and with project managers regarding timing. A major effort is underway to create an integrated work plan (UCSC work plan has been submitted). Reps from each campus have been attending FSPD (Future State Process Design) summits going over 65 processes (GL, payroll, benefits, etc) and collecting each location's issues, which are then rated and documented.
